Level Finder: matching reader to text (in 5 minutes)

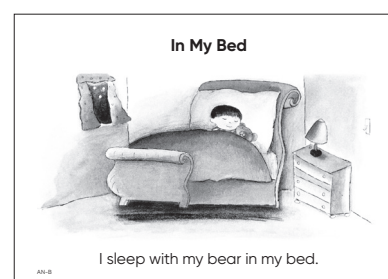
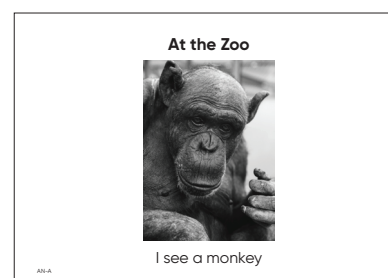
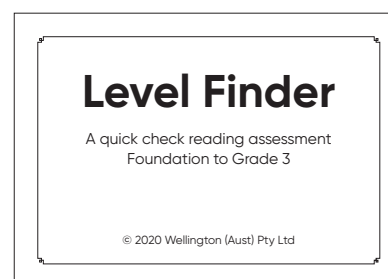
- Quick and accurate assessment of reading level
- Links to standard reading levels
- Easy to use:
 - o give student the level finder cards
 - o student selects a comfortable read
 - o student reads selection to you
 - o student takes a book from the identified level box

Easy to Use in Five Steps

1. Give the student the *Level Finder Cards* in order from A-O and say
“Select the card that you can read most comfortably – not too easy, not too hard”
2. In order to confirm the student’s selection, have the student read the text aloud.
3. Refer to the bottom left corner of the *Level Finder Card* to identify *reading level.
4. Allow student to select a book from the relevant level book box
5. At a later stage ask the student to read the book to you and then retell it. Adjust their reading level based on their ability to comprehend the text at literal and inferential levels.
